

## **PUBLIC TRANSPORT TO MUNTGEBOUW UTRECHT**

Take the train to Utrecht Central Station. When you arrive at the station you can choose different transport options. You can go by tram, bus or walk to Muntgebouw Utrecht.

### **Option 1 - Tram**

Take line 60 or 61 towards Nieuwegein-IJsselstein and take the stop 'Graadt van Roggenweg'. At the end of the tram platform turn right and cross the street. Then cross the street diagonally towards 'Koningsbergerstraat' and walk down this street. Turn left at the end towards the 'Leidseweg'. You will find Muntgebouw Utrecht after a short walk at your left hand.

### **Option 2 - Bus**

Take one of the following buses:

- Line 4 to Terwijde.
- Line 5 to Oog in Al.
- Line 7 to Kanaleneiland.
- Line 85 to Leerdam Station.
- Line 90 to Rotterdam Zuidplein.
- Qliner 387 to Gorinchem Station.
- Qliner 388 to Dordrecht Central Station.

Exit the bus at 'Graadt van Roggenweg'. This is the second bus stop. Then cross the street diagonally on your right, towards the 'Koningsbergerstraat' and walk down this street. Turn left at the end towards the 'Leidseweg'. You will find Muntgebouw Utrecht after a short walk at your left hand.

### **Option 3 - Walking from Utrecht Central Station**

The walk to Muntgebouw Utrecht, it takes approximately 10 minutes from Utrecht Central Station. Take the exit Jaarbeursplein at Utrecht CS. Walk across the Jaarbeursplein and cross the street named Croeselaan and then turn right. You will pass the Volksbank building on your left. Cross the streets at the traffic lights on the corner of the Volksbank building (named Graadt van Roggenweg). Walk towards the canal and turn left here towards de 'Leidseweg'. You will find Muntgebouw Utrecht after a five minute walk on your left.
